Economic Benefits

<p>364,760,723 visits per year resulted in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$11,330,054,492 in spending on trips to Corps lakes. • 91.0% of the spending was captured by the local economy as direct sales effects. <p>With multiplier effects, visitor trip spending resulted in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • \$26,957,619,396 in total sales. • 188,895 of jobs. • \$7,664,549,755 in labor income. • \$13,301,047,850 in value added (wages & salaries, payroll benefits, profits, rents, and indirect business taxes). 	<p>Benefits in Perspective</p> <p>The money spent by visitors to Corps lakes on trip expenses adds to the local and national economies by supporting jobs and generating income.
